to occupy positions in Alcatel, Coca-Cola, FEMSA, and HSBC. He also engages in consultancy activities for marketing and consumer analytics for market research agencies in the United States and Mexico.

Dr. Reyes-Mercado has focused a prolific research track on the adoption and diffusion of innovations. Many of his papers, included in Scopus-ranked journals, explain the interaction among drivers that lead to higher uptake of new products in the realms of renewable energy, fitness technology, and virtual reality. Another research line of Dr. Reyes-Mercado refers to developing insights in the field of entrepreneurial marketing. In collaboration with The Failure Institute, an international organization focused on assessing entrepreneurship failure, he developed research aimed at understanding how organizational and personal flexibilities and rigidities lead to the development of resiliency in young entrepreneurs. Having a keen interest in developing business case studies from the emerging economies standpoint, he recently co-edited the book "Reverse Entrepreneurship in Latin America: Internationalization from Emerging Markets to Developed Economies". A visiting professor at the Institute of Public Enterprise (Republic of India), and the University of Saint Francis of Quito, Ecuador; Dr. Reyes-Mercado is currently working on a 3-year Mexican Government-funded research project aimed at assessing how innovations can be diffused in society at a faster pace through the use of demand-side policies.
