Doctoral Colloquium (DC)



Submission Guidelines

A 1500-word extended abstract will be considered for selecting the papers that will be presented at the conference. Abstracts must clearly state the objective of the study, methodology, results, discussion, implications, and references. Only those abstracts that obtain the reviewers' acceptance after being reviewed blindly will be selected for presentation at the conference. It is expected that at least one author will attend the conference and deliver the paper if the abstract is accepted. The article must be unique and must not be submitted to a journal or another conference simultaneously. Please note that all of the authors' affiliations (full affiliations without abbreviations) and the contact information for the presenting author should be included in the abstracts. The similarity index for the submitted extended abstract should not be more than 10% excluding references.

Space between line and paragraph: 1.5 Margins: 1-inch (2.5cm) margin all around

Document Type: Word

Shillong is connected to Assam, Manipur, Tripura, West Bengal, and New Delhi through direct flights. Shillong can also be reached by taxi from Guwahati Airport/Railway Station which is about 120 km away. Guwahati Airport is well-connected to most of the major cities in India including Bangalore, Chennai, Delhi, Mumbai, and Kolkata. Helicopter services are also available between Guwahati and Shillong.
